1. **NAME:** The name of the Club is "The Mid-Hants Railway Preservation Society 200 Club" (The Club").
2. **OBJECT:** The object of The Club is to raise funds for the Mid-Hants Railway Preservation Society.
3. **MEMBERSHIP:** Membership of The Club shall initially be limited to 200 persons: each member must be 18 years of age or over.
4. **TRUSTEES:** The Club shall be administered by three trustees appointed annually by the Board of the Society. The trustees shall elect a Treasurer from amongst their number to be responsible for keeping the accounts of The Club and arranging for the payment of prizes and the transfer of surplus income to the Society. The decision of the trustees in any matter relating to the operation of The Club shall be final.
5. **SUBSCRIPTIONS:** The annual subscription to The Club shall be £ 12.00 payable upon admission to The Club. The subscription may be paid by cheque or banker's order. A member may hold more than one membership.
6. **PRIZES:**
  - a) A draw shall take place on four occasions in each year. There shall be 5 prizes awarded in each draw in the amounts of £ 150, £ 75 and three of £ 25.
  - b) A qualifying factor is that at least three payments of £ 1 each have been received before an entry in the next draw can be made.
  - c) Each draw will be made by or under the direction of the trustees. The results of each draw will be announced in the Mid-Hants News next following the date of the draw.
  - d) Prize winners will be notified in writing of their entitlement to receive a prize, and payment will be made by cheque posted to the address shown on the membership application form or to such other address as the member may have subsequently notified the trustees.
  - e) In the event that the membership of The Club is less than 200 members in any quarter, the trustees shall be entitled to reduce the amounts of the prizes or the number of draws (or both) provided however, that in these circumstances the ratio of prize money to subscription shall not be affected.
  - f) If the number of applications for membership exceeds 200 the trustees may elect to increase either the amount of each prize or the number of prizes awarded in each draw (or both) provided however, that in these circumstances the ratio of prize money to subscriptions shall not be affected.
7. **ACCOUNTS:** The accounts of The Club shall be kept by the Treasurer and shall be audited annually by the Society's auditors. The Treasurer shall keep a roll of membership and each membership shall be allocated a roll number.
