

## Supper Talks

The first talk is entitled *Wings Over Europe*, given by Clare Grange, an experienced private pilot.

It will be a light and (hopefully!) entertaining presentation, beginning with a brief explanation about flight training and qualifications, the subjects studied and exams taken, but this would be purely to provide background.
